

THEATRE FACTS!

Why does Annie keep banging on about 'go off stage right', 'move outstage' and what does she mean???

Back Wall

Audience

Collectively there are three stage right areas, upstage right, centre stage right and downstage right – the same applies to the centre and the stage left areas.

Oh, and by the way, each position relates to the performer who is standing on the stage – so – stage right is your right when facing the audience and so on.

The upstage areas are the ones at the back and downstage areas are at the front – why UP and DOWN? Well, way back in history, audiences sat on benches or stood around on flat floors so, to enable them to see better, the stages were built sloping up towards the back. If you go to some the older West End theatres they still have what are called 'raked stages' even though they now have tiered or raked seating in stalls and circles. Today's buildings are seldom built solely as theatres but are multipurpose and so raked stages would not be practical. They also usually have tiered or raked seating which folds into the back of the auditorium leaving a large flat floor area suitable for non-theatrical functions.
